Thank you for your interest in the Sgt. Chris Workman Memorial Scholarship. The friends and family of Chris Workman have established a scholarship fund to help deserving students who are hoping to further their education. Recipients can either be a graduating high school senior, or a student currently enrolled in an institution of higher education with an emphasis in art. This application will have a patriotic essay included as part of the selection process.

To be considered for a scholarship, the candidate must completely fill out the attached application form. The scholarship shall be used for full-time undergraduate study and can be used at any American college, university, trade, or vocational school approved by the selection Committee. The primary selection criteria shall be ability and need. The recipient must be in good standing academically with a minimum grade point average of 3.00 G.P.A.

Applications for the scholarship must be post marked by May 1st. The decision by the selection committee of the recipient will be made no later than May 10th. Minico graduates who receive the scholarship will be asked to attend the Senior Awards ceremony at the Wilson Theater for recognition.

GENERAL INFORMATION

On the night of April 19th 2012, the crew of Diamond Head 20, and the Medivac Helicopter (dust-off) accepted a mission to retrieve wounded Afghani policemen who had been injured by a suicide bomber at a check point in Helmed Province. At the time of the mission, a large wind storm had been passing through the region and had grounded other aircraft in the area because of the dust and poor visibility. As conditions seemed to be improving, the decision was made to attempt the flight. Unfortunately, ambient light that evening was not available. (Red illum) Conditions deteriorated as the crew and the craft began their flight. Ground reference was lost and as the pilot attempted to turn around he became disoriented, the rotors of the craft hit the terrain and caused the gunship to crash. All four crew members were lost.
